The purchase of the new equipment was only realized—THANKS to the generous donation of **\$15,000 from Troy parents** plus a **\$16,000 grant from the Phelps Foundation**.

Q: Why was there a need to replace the equipment?

A: The former computers had limited processing capacity. The rigorous curriculum at Troy has technology integrated into all types of student activities including English, History, and yes even Math! It is important to keep the education of our students at the forefront of California Schools.

Q: What happen to the older models?

A: Good news is that the older models were recycled and shared with the library a other computer labs. The library is now able to provide every student greater access for research by more classes at one time.
